

Tuesday, 5 April 2016

Madison County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on 5 April 2016 at 09:02 in the board office following their attendance at the dept. head meeting. Chairman Clifton called the meeting to order with Supervisors Price and Duff present.

Price moved, Duff seconded, to approve the consent agenda with amended minutes regarding Hagan's comment on the closing of a road; motion carried unanimously. Supervisors reported on their boards. Notices included Recorder's report of MAR fees collected and Sheriff's report of MAR activity.

Co. Engineer Todd Hagan met with the Board. Secondary Roads work requests completed in MAR included 29 rock patches, 34 signs, 31 equipment-related issues, one bridge patch, two water crossings and four pavement patches, and 12 driveway permits and four utility permits were approved.

Harry Pettit was in attendance to express his concerns regarding Madison Co. bridges and wondered if they are included on the Secondary Road Five Year Construction Program as well as when is the time frame for bids going out.

Shannon Brown was in attendance to discuss the Resolution for the Central Iowa Recovery (CIR) Business Line of Credit. Clifton will call Tim Bedford, Executive Director of CIR, to discuss details, so the Resolution was tabled until the 12 APR board meeting.

Price moved, Duff seconded, to approve the 2016 County Weed Commissioner Certification; motion carried unanimously.

Duff moved, Price seconded, to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Madison Co. and the Iowa Dept. of Corrections that an offender who is alleged to have committed a violation of parole and is to be placed on parole to Madison Co. solely for that parole violation shall be transferred and held at the Newton Correctional Facility pending his parole revocation hearing; motion carried unanimously.

Clifton moved, Duff seconded, to approve the Secondary Road Five Year Construction Program; motion carried unanimously. Jennifer Porter of East Peru inquired about the plan to repair Brown Street, the Farm-to-Market road. Clifton asked Hagan to attempt to work in that road for repair when a crew is working in the area in 2018.

Price moved, Duff seconded, to approve the Vote Tabulation System Contract between Madison Co. and Henry M. Adkins & Son Inc.; motion carried unanimously.

Duff moved, Price seconded, to approve the Application for Courtyard Use for CRISP Pinwheel Gardens for Child Abuse Prevention Month (APR); motion carried unanimously.

Duff moved, Price seconded, W-040516 2016 Noxious Weed Control for Madison Co.

Nancy Forrest requested an update on the County's comprehensive plan review process.
