

More than 50,000 students participated in the statewide 2016 Iowa Youth Presidential Straw Poll on Tuesday, 26 January. The Straw Poll was organized and the results were tabulated by the Iowa Secretary of State. Students voted in both Republican and Democratic Straw Polls.
