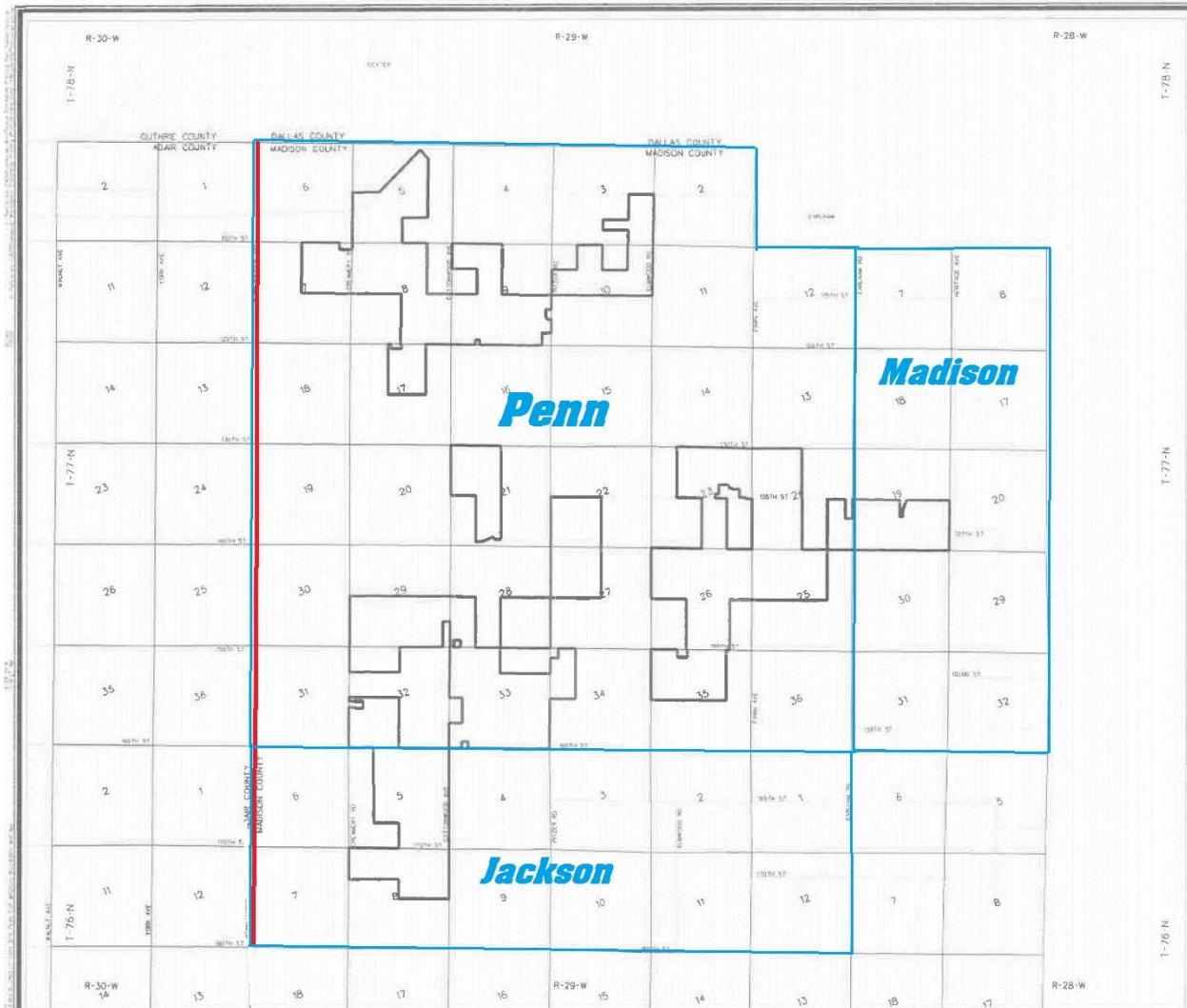
You may appear and offer your support for or objections to the MidAmerican Energy Company Arbor Hill Project request at the public hearings stated below:
